## Who can apply?

Anyone can apply whether you are from a local community, voluntary or non-profit organisation, even informal groups can apply for funding from £30 to £3000 to put ideas into action.

You don't have to be an existing organisation/group to apply for funding and we can help you complete your application. Activities will have to take place in George St, Castlehill & Pittodrie or City Centre Community Council areas and benefit local people.

## What are we looking for?

Your project should:

- Benefit your community and the people who live there
- Help people feel included in their community.
- Help to make George St, Castlehill & Pittodrie or City Centre areas even better places.
- Be fully costed, including maintenance and installation if relevant. We can help you with costing and developing your idea.

Ideas for projects of any size are welcome. Whether you want to organise a community garden, a graffiti wall, outdoor table tennis, street sports, a lunch club, computer classes, cycle repair workshops or a community fridge - there is no limit but your imagination!

## How do you apply?

To apply for the funding you must complete and return an application form by **5pm on Wednesday 31 January 2018**. If your idea meets the criteria you will then need to present your project to the local community at an event in March 2018. Those in attendance will vote for their favourite projects and a decision will be made on the day. Please submit one application for each idea you would like funding for. You can apply for more than one but the total of all applications should not exceed £5000.



The Fairer Aberdeen Board has set aside money for you to decide how it is spent. With Your Streets, Your Say U DECIDE which projects are needed in your area.
